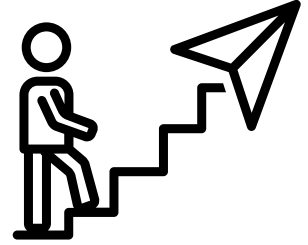


- Ewell Castle School is committed to providing a Careers Education and Guidance (CEG) programme for all students in Years 7 – 13.

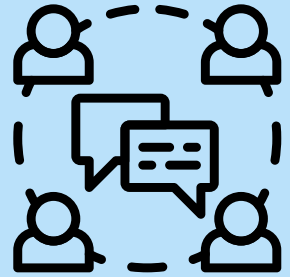

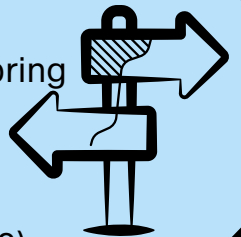
