## LEGACY INFORMATION

### **Ewell Castle Development Department Vision**

Our School vision is to inspire, engage and excel all our pupils to achieve their best and to ensure all our children thrive. Under its public benefit provision, the School currently offers a number of bursaries to families who would not otherwise be able to afford a Ewell Castle School education for their children. Demand is high and as the School's funds are limited, we are not able to assist as many children as we would like to.

By providing an increased number of bursaries, (both from new external applicants as well as from existing Ewell Castle pupils who are looking to stay on to enjoy and flourish within our Sixth Form) we are endorsing our School value of *social responsibility* and promoting diversity and inclusivity. It is our aim that funds raised via the Ewell Castle School Legacy Appeal, will go directly towards our bursary provision and in so doing help a greater number of pupils enjoy the academic and social benefits and friendships that a Ewell Castle education can provide.

Ewell Castle can be the stepping-stone to a bright and successful future, and we would like to be able to offer financial assistance to a greater number of our qualifying Year 11 pupils, along with new external applicants for the Sixth Form, regardless of their family's financial situation.
