Enter: Your subject area of interest (one word is best)

Entry Year: 2022-2023 *

Choose this even you are looking to go after this -
Courses will not change significantly for future applications

Study level: Leave at Undergraduate
(Undergraduate covers study undertaken straight after 6th Form)

Next screen - **Use left hand (black) FILTER column to:**

Specify exactly what course eg: *Business and Finance, Aerospace Engineering, Adult Nursing*

Specify a single university (if you have a specific one in mind)

Highlight an area of the UK you want to study in

SEARCH facility throws up a long list of courses that might interest you.

Open those you are attracted to, using the **View Option** button if prompted

On the Course Information page:

Read the COURSE SUMMARY – Is this what you are looking for?

Scroll down to check ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Click on A Level Grades, UCAS Tariff points or BTEC Grades buttons to show more about grade requirements and if specific A Level / BTEC subjects are needed*

*Often universities specify only ONE essential A Level subject.

Occasionally universities want TWO essential A Level subjects – this is relatively uncommon

Many courses require no specific A Level subjects eg: Business (but may require Maths GCSE at a given grade)

EITHER Entry Requirements are expressed as qualifications with grades eg: '3 A Levels at BBB including English'

eg: 'Pearson BTEC DDM'

OR as a number eg: 120 Points – UCAS Tariff points. Please refer to the UCAS Tariff online or School help-sheet
