There is a wealth of textbooks biographies and general books covering the career of Mussolini and Fascist Italy in general. I have two more textbooks that will be given to the pupils when we reach that time.</p> <p>The first part of the course 1900 – 1918 is less well covered by writers in English as indeed is the period 1871 to 1900. However there is material on that part of the course and pupils need to be well read.
