SPORTS DEPARTMENT EXPECTATIONS

Pupils and parents should be aware of the following expectations regarding school sport and participation. It is important that all pupils strive to do their best and to act in a sporting manner at all times when participating in school sport.

The School expects:

- All pupils who are selected in a school team squad to attend all weekly training sessions and all fixtures
- Pupils should prioritise school sport over external clubs, unless these are of a county/national standard or similar
- All pupils to request in writing to the Director of Sport advance permission to be excused from a school fixture (Please note this may not be granted)

The PE/Sports Department will:

- Provide a fully comprehensive fixtures programme
- Communicate effectively to parents arrangements for fixtures/events through the school sports website.

Pupils should:

- Attend all fixtures and practice sessions
- Turn up on time and perform to the best of their ability
- Feel proud to be able to represent Ewell Castle School

These activities do not take place without the continued support from parents/carers and the involvement of you, the pupil's. The PE/Sports Department recognises the contribution you, as pupils and your parents/carers make to the success of our extra-curricular programme.

Each pupil should be proud to represent the school and understand the virtues and values that participation in sporting activities bring.
